

BROMACS TAKE AN EASY THREE AT HORSHAM

Three Bromac horses lined up at Horsham this past Monday (June 7) and three impressive wins were the result.

First up was the smart three year old **Eton Bromac** (Bettor's Delight – **Ester Bromac**) who made it look easy backing up a 1:59.3 win at Shepparton on May 24th, with an end to end victory in the second race of the day.

The **Bettor's Delight** gelding has been super consistent this season with 9 wins and 2 seconds from just 13 starts.

The following race saw the return to the racetrack of promising **Mystical Shark** mare **Baji Bromac**. Although she was making her Australian debut she has actually been in Australia since September 2007!

A lightly raced winner in NZ, her last start there saw her running a good fourth to the smart performer **Rudiani**, winner of 15 races and over \$131,000 in NZ and Australia to date.

Baji Bromac (Mystical Shark – **Blyton**) drew 6 on the front line in her Australian debut but there was enough talk about her on track to see her go out a clear favourite.

She showed gate speed at the start to hit the lead and was never in doubt afterwards, coming home almost half a length clear of the runner up Igetaround and more than 6 metres clear of the third horse.

The field was well spread out behind her in an impressive and long awaited debut on Australian soil.

The final Bromac horse was not until race 8, the last race of the day and it was in a heat of the Tontine Series for trotters.

Just missing out on first favouritism, his name was **Zanzi Bromac** (**Red River Hanover** – **Zanzibar**) and his last start had seen him finish 3rd in the **Group 1** VICBred 4YO Trotters Final.

Off 20m, this promising trotter was three wide for most of the race before being punched up in pursuit of the leaders as the bell lap sounded. He didn't get to the lead quickly or easily as the field lifted their speed, but halfway down the back straight he got his head in front and that was it for the rest of the journey.

Clear as they turned for home, he gave nothing else a look in and raced to the line untouched, with almost 8 metres the winning margin.

Zanzi Bromac has raced just six times this season but has notched up 4 wins and 2 thirds as he continues to thrive with time and experience.
